The number of trips SALT's teachers take has been growing each year.

- In 2015 we made 25 trips.
- In 2016 we made 28 trips to Peru, Chile, Argentina and Spain.

Each trip lasts an average of two to three weeks and includes teaching in three to five cities. Final figures for 2016 are not yet in, but we estimate we had **1,700 students**, and according to an informal survey of the ministries each of them has, we further estimate that the teaching those pastors and leaders receive via SALT has been multiplied exponentially to about **17,000 to 20,000 other people.** That's really stretching the impact of our dollars.

In 2017,

- SALT will be adding a new country to our list of destinations Paraguay, where we had worked a number of years ago.
- We are also awaiting scheduling dates to start work in Germany.

SALT also has been involved in a number of special projects. In 2016:

- We raised funds and sent \$7,000 to Peru to replace a car that one man uses to drive us all around the Lima area. We also need \$300 a year to help buy insurance for that car.
- We sent \$1,000 to Temuco, Chile, to help build classrooms in a church where we teach.
- We provided another \$2,900 to a church in Ayacucho, Peru, to build a roof over what had been an open-air teaching area.
- In addition, we gave \$300 to that church to buy more tables and chairs for the students.

In 2016.

- SALT spent nearly \$1,200 in scholarship money to help make it possible for pastors to attend our seminary program, SETE (Seminary Education by Theological Extension).
- We provided \$1,600 in air fare to author and teacher Dr. Douglas Moo to travel to Argentina to establish a doctoral-level theological program.
- We sent \$5,000 to help rebuild the kitchen facilities for a new School of Missions in Alicante, Spain.
- We sent another \$1,000 in scholarship money to the missions school to help students attend.
- In addition, we provided two teachers for the school and two construction workers for the kitchen project.

Total funds used in Projects during 2016: \$20,300.

In 2017:

- We hope to send another \$6,000 to the School of Missions in Spain for continued support of scholarships and for renovations and expansion of the site.
- We have an opportunity to take on a well-known Chilean pastor who is retiring

and is willing to travel throughout South America for SALT as a teacher and developer of our ministries there. That will cost about \$6,000 per year (\$500 per month).

- We also hope to raise \$3,000 in one-time "love in action" funds to assist pastors who have special and unforeseen needs.
- And we need to raise about \$2,000 in scholarship money to help pastors and other leaders who cannot afford on their own to get to our teaching centers or buy textbooks.
- We also need to raise about 13 percent of our expenses to cover the administrative costs of running this otherwise totally volunteer program.

The total we need for 2017 is approximately \$18,500.

SALT has grown over the past two and a half years to where we now have about 70 people with specific tasks and responsibilities "working" for us on three continents – North and South America and Europe. And SALT does all of this entirely through **volunteer help**. We have no paid staff or teachers. We do what we can as the Lord lays the desire to help – by prayer and financially – on people just like you.
